

BOROUGHMUIR BLAZE BASKETBALL CLUB

HEAD COACH / ASSITANT COACH ROLE DESCRIPTION

Coaching for Blaze includes (but is not restricted to) the duties, behaviours and criteria listed below.

Duties and behaviours:

- 1. Having fun with the players
- 2. Creating an environment of enjoyment and safety that encourages players to make decisions for themselves and retains them within basketball for the long term
- 3. Acting as a champion for the club's culture of fun, learning and development
- 4. Committing to the long-term development of individual club members above winning games
- 5. Ensuring every player has a meaningful role in every game they play
- 6. Planning and delivering weekly training sessions and games (typically 1-2 training sessions per week and 1-4 games per month)
- 7. Maintaining high standards of conduct, communication and coaching ethics
- 8. Appropriate communication with players and parents/carers
- 9. Work within the philosophies and code of conduct of basketballscotland

Criteria:

- 1. Has a genuine interest in wanting to develop players, coaches and officials with a genuine enthusiasm for the game
- 2. Role models healthy and positive behaviours for the players
- 3. Has some experience of playing or coaching basketball
- 4. Is an effective communicator, including a willingness to listen to players and fellow coaches
- 5. Has experience which demonstrates he/she is well organised and plans ahead
- 6. Is a qualified coach (or working towards a coaching qualification)
- 7. Has attended in the last three years (or is willing to attend) courses in Child Protection and sports First Aid (Blaze will cover any costs)
- 8. Has an outstanding disciplinary record and seeks to defuse any potential conflict with all stakeholders including visiting opponents, supporters and officials
- 9. Maintains positive and productive relationships with staff of the Crags Centre and **basketball**scotland

Time commitment:

Blaze coaches typical invest 2-10 hours per week into the development of the people they coach.

Duration:

The successful applicant will be offered a one year appointment with the option to add a subsequent year at the discretion of the panel.

Volunteering:

These are volunteer roles. Reasonable expenses will be covered.
